Only 3% of the 500 billion plastic bags produced every year, get recycled?



Marine mammals are showing us our future – we need to change our ways.

- Globally, **100,000 marine mammals die every year** as a result of plastic pollution. This includes whales, dolphins, porpoises, seals and sea lions.
- The **declining health of ocean-going mammals**, especially the increase in various cancers, sends an undeniable message to

humans. Marine mammals are therefore showing us our future – unless we change our ways.

- Just like us, marine mammals can't breathe underwater, and the most common way that entanglement kills is through drowning.
- It's estimated that 56% of the planet's whale, dolphin and porpoise species have consumed plastic as their sophisticated use of sonar confuses plastic pollution as food.

A PLASTIC BAG, FULL OF WATER can look a lot like squid, or other prey, to the SEALS & MARINE MAMMALS that hunt them

12.7 million of **PLASTIC WASTE** produced each year ends up in our **OCEANS**

PLASTIC POLLUTION causes unnecessary deaths in marine mammals through suffocation, starvation and drowning

An estimated **640,000 tonnes** of the 12 million tonnes of plastic that enters the oceans every year is so-called ghost fishing equipment, gear that's either deliberately jettisoned or washed from ships or shorelines.
